## CONDITIONS OF ATTENDANCE

1. The Central New Jersey Council will determine a Scout's (or Scouter's) eligibility for attendance at the National Jamboree as part of the Council Contingent.
2. All applications will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis; in the event that more applications are received than slots are available, the Council will notify Scouts and Scouters that they have the option of being wait-listed, or having their deposit returned.
3. Deposits and payments are non-refundable, but they are transferable in the event that a Scout or Scouter drops out of the Contingent of their own choice.
4. All attendees (Adult and Youth) agree to procure the required uniform(s) in the required quantities, and to be properly uniformed at all times while attending the Jamboree, as well as while engaged in pre- and post-Jamboree activities.
5. All attendees are required to adhere to the payment schedule (to be published after July 1, 2008), and understand that non-adherence to this schedule may place the Scout or Scouter in jeopardy of forfeiting their slot in the Contingent.
6. A Scout who fails to attain the rank of First Class by July 1, 2010 will be dropped from the contingent, and will forfeit 50% of all fees paid.
7. All Scouts and Scouters attending as members of the Council Contingent will obtain a valid Class III BSA physical that will be valid throughout the course of the Jamboree and any post-Jamboree activities.
8. All Scouts and Scouters selected to be members of the Council Contingent agree to attend all Troop and Contingent training sessions in preparation for the National Jamboree, and understand that non-attendance or failure to complete the training may subject them to forfeit their slot in the Contingent.
